What happens in UPRP represents what happens in many other places worldwide, including across the EU and in the EPO.



Despite serving as Director of the IT Department since 2020, Justyn Łojko failed to implement effective data security measures.


The report notes operational lapses such as non-transparent data processing systems, delays in publishing information, and vulnerabilities potentially affecting the privacy of UPRP staff.



Where jobs are notorious as bribes or tenures "rewarded" for complicity in illegal things






